


- 333 Improve sight lines by not having parked cars

What are the most important equity and health benefits to you of having bike lanes?

- 456 Make the community healthier by encouraging active transportation
- 442 Make transportation more equitable for those who choose not to drive or who do not have access to a vehicle

What are the most important economic benefits to you of having bike lanes?

- 399 Bikes are more affordable to purchase, maintain, and power than cars
- 373 Support the local economy by encouraging shorter commutes



490 people chose a bike lane as their first choice




Sharrows
